Brief Notes re TEMEIN Work Sheets

1. The Temein people call themselves *brɔ̄ŋe*(?), sg. *brɔ̄ŋintɛt*. This really means 'human being(s)', as with many peoples in the world. (Cf. Nyimang self-name ama 'people'.)

Some minor variations occur with different speakers. As initial vowel I have sometimes heard o- in the sg. but not in the pl. I have also heard *brɔ̄ŋi*(?) in the pl. The glottal stop is not always found. The first vowel can also be omitted: *rɔ̄ŋe*(?).

Place = (*ò*)*rɔ̄ŋo*(?) or *laaq na rɔ̄ŋo*(?) (place of...)
(1st vowel elided after na. -o = Locative suffix)

Language = *lóngɔ̄ na rɔ̄ŋe*(?) (speech of *brɔ̄ŋe*(?))

Re the name 'Temein' I enclose a copy of 2 pp from an MS of mine.

Bayreuth staff of Afrikanistik II (Franz Rottland, Angelika Jakobi and Rainer Vossen) collected Temein vocabulary in the course of their researches in NW Nuba Mtns, though there are many gaps in their glosses. I have been arranging their equivalents with mine in lists on the lines of Tucker's Moru-Madi vocabulary. We agree fairly widely, including tone, though they often differ among themselves. I include 2 sheets (from the Nouns) as a sample. They were using i and ï, also u and ü. (However, Angelika tells me that her undotted i doesn't always represent a retracted vowel.) I have kept these in my Work sheets for you, but I don't think the distinction is phonemic. (However, it remains to be seen whether there is a place for them in vowel harmony.) Of my informants, some use p and some f; theirs seem to have used f. In the Work sheets I have used p all the time, though equally f could replace it. The p/f situation seems to be free variation, though it is not clear whether dialectal differences also play a part. (We need to know a lot more about dialects within the Temein range itself.)

3. There is also free variation between s and š, d and 'd (implosive) b and 'b, j and 'j. However, I have marked Implosive sounds when I have definitely heard them; and also omitted them in cases where, e.g., I have heard d and 'd from different speakers, as *dal* and 'dal (child). k/g: voicing is common in intervocalic positions, and in the lists I have often indicated this. There are other variations which may be seen on the Work sheets, e.g. final glottal stop varies frequently with speaker. Final -k in verbs often indicates an intransitive, but it seems that the system is gradually breaking down.

t, d are dental; t,d alveolar, slightly retroflex.
